Tee Level Introductory Clinic Coordinator Contract

By signing this contract on the reverse side, I am stating that I understand and will abide by the following Tee Level Introductory Clinic policies.

- Youngsters participating must (1) have never played golf before (2) do not own a set of golf clubs and (3) are encouraged to be between the ages of 7-14 (club sizes are most appropriate for that age).
- A minimum of 8 participants are required for a Tee Level Clinic.
- One instructor/volunteer per every 8 participants is recommended.
- If you plan on hosting a clinic that has more than 50 youngsters, please notify the National Office in advance.
- The program safety precautions will be complied with as outlined in the Hook A Kid On Golf program manual
- **The deadline for ordering supplies is three weeks prior to the scheduled clinic date.**
- **The supply order form must be accompanied by a check, credit card or signed purchase order for payment in full to be processed.**
- A minimum of 12 hours of instruction as outlined in the manual but not including the final day outing are to be completed in the Tee Level Clinic.
- Three 30 minute special presentations outlined in the manual should be conducted throughout the week.
- All participants will receive their Hook A Kid On Golf clubs and bags to keep after the successful completion of the clinic unless otherwise approved by the National Office.
